REGULATIONS

- 1. <u>Interpretations:</u> In these Regulations unless the context otherwise requires:
 - (a) "Act" shall mean the Local Government Act, 1966.
 - (b) "Council" shall mean the Town Council of the Town of Channel Port aux Basques.
 - (c) "Town" shall mean the Town of Channel Port aux Basques as defined by paragraph 2 of Order-in-Council dated the 12th day of December, A.D., 1950, and made under the said Act.
 - (d) "Animal" means any domestic animal but shall not be held to mean dogs and cats.
- 2. From and after the date of the passing of these Regulations no live animal shall be kept within the Town, except with the permission of Council in writing.
- 3. Every person who neglects, contravenes or fails to comply with any provision of these regulations shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars or in default of payment of such fine to imprisonment for a period not exceeding ninety days, or to both such fine and imprisonment.
- 4. These Regulations shall come into effect on the day of March,
 A.D., 1969 and may be cited as the Town of Channel Port aux
 Basques (Prohibiting of Animals) Regulations, 1969.
