## MOBILE VEHICLE REGULATIONS

## 1. Interpretations:

In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires:

- (a) "Act" means The Municipalities Act, 1979. Section M. 24
- (b) "Council" means the Town Council of the Town of Labrador City.
- (c) "Town" means the Town of Labrador City as defined by Order-in-Council dated the 27th day of June 1961, and any amendments thereto, according to the Municipalities Act.
- (d) "Vehicle" means a device in, upon, or by which a person, property, goods, food, merchandise, may be transported or drawn upon a street or highway.
- 2. No person shall operate or use any type of vehicle within the boundaries of the Town for the sale of food, goods, or merchandise of any kind thereon or therefrom, whether the vehicle is self-moving or drawn by another vehicle, and whether it is mobile or immobile, or is temporarily or permanently stationary, without first having obtained a permit from the Council.
- 3. Any person who neglects, contravenes, or fails to comply with the Regulations shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding One Hundred dollars (\$100.00), or in default of payment of such fine, to imprisonment for a period not exceeding ninety days, or to both such fine and imprisonment.

## Mobile Vehicle Regulations

4. These Regulations were passed and adopted by Council on the 28th day of May 1981, and will come into effect on the 28th day of May 1981, and may be cited as the Town of Labrador City (Mobile Vehicle) Regulations, 1981.
