OUTDOOR SWIMMING POOLS

Permanent, non-seasonal pools require a Building Permit from the Town of Gander.

Where a swimming pool is an accessory use in a residential or commercial zone it shall:

- a) Be protected by a barrier or fence having a minimum height of 1.5 metres and located a minimum of 1.5 meters from the water surface, and have a gate, equipped with self-closing, self-latching devices placed at the top and on the inside of the gate.
- b) Not encroach upon any easement
- c) Location/Sideyards refer to Accessory Building Regulations

Definition

Swimming Pool means an artificial body of water, excluding ponds, of more than $9.3m^2$ (100 square feet) in an area or 11′ 3″ in diameter, used for bathing, swimming, or diving.
