Pursuant to the power conferred by Section 174 of The Municipalities Act, the Town Council of Labrador City has made the following Regulations:

SNOW CLEARING REGULATIONS

1. Interpretations:

In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires:

- (a) "Act" means The Municipalities Act of 1979. 1969 M-24.
- (b) "Council" means the Town Council of the Town of Labrador City.
- (c) "Town" means the Town of Labrador City as defined by Order-in-Council dated the 27th day of June 1961, and any amendments thereto, according to the Municipalities Act.
- (d) "Unattended Vehicle" means a vehicle not under the control of a person authorized to operate the vehicle, and in the case of a motor vehicle not under the control of a person holding a valid and subsisting driver's license issued under and in accordance with the Highway Traffic Act 1962, and the Regulations made under the said Act.
- 2. During the period from October 15th in each year to April 30th in the succeeding year, both days inclusive, no person shall park an unattended vehicle on any street within the limits of the Town.
- 3. Any vehicle which is left standing upon a public road, sidewalk, or bridge in such a position that it may hinder or impede the ploughing of or removal of snow or ice therefrom, shall be removed to a place designated by Council and impounded therein by a person so authorized.

Snow Clearing Regulations

- 4. The owner of any vehicle removed under the provisions of Section (3) shall not be permitted to claim the vehicle and remove it from the place of impoundment until such time as all towing and administration charges as prescribed by Council have been paid.
- 5. No person shall deposit, throw, sweep, or place any accumulation of snow or ice on any street or on any public parking lot within the limits of the Town, providing that this Regulation shall not apply to employees or contractors of the Council while engaged in snow clearing operations.
- 6. Any person who violates any of the provisions of these Regulations shall be guilty of an offence, and shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or, in default of payment of such penalty, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months, and shall upon conviction of the first offence be liable to a penalty not less than \$10.00; for the second offence not less than \$25.00; and for the third offence not less than \$50.00.
- 7. Prosecution of these Regulations may be taken summarily by any police constable.
- 8. These Regulations were passed and adopted by Council on the 4th day of December 1980, and will come into effect on the 4th day of December 1980, and may be cited as the Town of Labrador City (Snow Clearing) Regulations, 1980.
