



## **EXPRESSION OF INTEREST**

### **Land Use Planning Referral Program**

Municipalities Newfoundland and Labrador (MNL) was formed in 1951 as an umbrella organization mandated to represent municipal government interests, and as a vehicle for municipal leaders to share information and resources. MNL represents the 276 cities, towns and Inuit Community Governments in Newfoundland and Labrador that service 85 per cent of the population, as well as their 2000 leaders.

MNL is accepting expressions of interest from qualified firms or individuals for the provision of a land use planning referral program to its members. This program would provide telephone-based advice to MNL's members at no cost. In return, the successful proponent/service provider would receive public recognition as an MNL Preferred Supplier and would have access to MNL's weekly mailout for marketing purposes.

In return for exclusive access to MNL membership and the designation as a MNL Membership Service Provider, the successful firm or individual would also be expected to maintain a minimum profile with the membership through sponsorship of the Annual Municipalities Newfoundland and Labrador Conference and Trade Show and/or a combination of one or more of the other events offered by MNL throughout the year.
