VACCINE PASSPORT

OVERVIEW AND INFORMATION



As of October 22nd, 2021, the Province has implemented a Vaccine Passport requirement. Within those requirements, the Recreation Centre and many Town programs/events are required to have participants provide their vaccine passports.

The Town/organizer will not have access to any personal information other than a green light for participants to take part. The Town/organizer will not hold any information, but will be requiring consent to keep a record that the participant has been verified, example:

A renter is responsible for verifying the vaccine passport and identification of all those that enter the building to attend the function. Everyone attending ages 12 and over will have to present their vaccine passports and ID to the organizer.

The renter/organizer will be required to download the NLVaxVerify app on their device to scan the QR codes, and keep a list of those in attendance.

How do I access NLVaxPass?

The app is free and available in the App Store or Play Store to download on a smart phone or a tablet. You can download NLVaxPass from the App Store (iOS device) or Play Store (Android device). The app will work on the following devices:

- · Apple devices: iPod Touch, iPhone 6 or an iPas with iOS 11 or later
- · Android devices: Version 8.1 or later
