

Food First NL's **vision** is a province where everyone can eat with dignity and joy.

Our **mission** is to advance the right to food in Newfoundland and Labrador.

We accomplish our mission through 4 pathways:

- Advocating
- Organizing
- Taking action
- Valuing people





Food Security in NL: A Snapshot



What is food security?

- When "all people, at all times, have physical, social, and economic access to sufficient, safe, and nutritious food that meets their food preferences and dietary needs for an active and healthy life."
- It's different from food self-sufficiency



What is food insecurity?

- Food insecurity is the inadequate or insecure access to food due to financial constraints.
- Includes marginal, moderate, and severe levels of food insecurity
- We usually talk about them together to capture how easy it is to move between categories





Almost 1 in 5 NLers was food insecure as of 2021.



NL has the highest share of children living in food insecure households of any province



The share of foodinsecure households who accessed a food program in a given month during the pandemic



Increase in food prices in 2022



How much of their income support cheque a family of 4 would need to spend to afford a "nutritious food basket"



Of our food is imported from out of province


System-level organizations

- At the ground level: hundreds of organizations and businesses, many government agencies



Big policy shifts

- Health Accord
- Social and Economic Well-Being Plan
- All-Party Committee on Basic Income



A growing role for municipalities

Municipalities are:

- Connectors
- Funders
- Enablers

Since the COVID-19 pandemic, they are also often **program operators**

Out of **228 applications** for pandemic food program funding administered by Food First NL, **34 came from municipalitie**s.





Municipal Food Action: Examples



Production: Killick Coast

- Agriculture Strategic Plan created by 6 Communities of Portugal Cove- St. Philip's, Logy Bay-Middle Cove-Outer Cove, Torbay, Bauline, Flat Rock and Pouch Cove
- Strategic themes include economic development, enterprise, healthy living, and policy
- PCSP Chamber of Commerce as backbone organization



Distribution: Food on the Move

- Mobile, pop-up, affordable food market
- Operates across St. John's in NL Housing Community Centres and MUN University Centre
- City of St. John's is a supporter in-kind and financial, aligning other programming



Access: Basic Income Advocacy

- Municipalities across Atlantic Canada are advocating for Basic Income
- Halifax, Fredericton, Moncton, Saint John, and St. John's have passed motions
- A chance to build momentum and influence provincial and national policy



Consumption: Community Freezers

- Supports wild food access in Inuit communities
- ICGs / Municipalities provides a reliable public space, equipment, staff supports receiving contributions and access



Disposal: Community Composting

- 15+ initiatives to divert organic waste and reduce disposal costs
- Operating at neighborhood and regional scales
- Funding through MMSB programs





Roles for Municipalities



The Big Picture

- Internal policy: Procurement, food charters, Food Policy Councils/Advisory Committees
- Funding and in-kind resources (assessments)
- Advocacy to government
- Food as economic development




