About Atlantic UOMA



- An industry-led, not-for-profit that operates the used oil and glycol recycling program in each of the four Atlantic provinces.
- In NL - since 2019 - Atlantic UOMA operates under a Stewardship Plan pursuant to the requirements of the Newfoundland and Labrador *Regulation 101/18 s1, Waste Management Regulations, 2003 (Amendment) under the Environmental Protection Act* (the Regulation) - Article 31.43(1).
- We act on behalf of the brand owners with respect to the brand owners' obligations under the Regulation (Articles 31.34 (a) and 31.37).
- The Association is recognized by the Multi-Materials Stewardship Board (MMSB) as the agent entitled to manage an integrated system of recovery and reclamation of all regulated products and to educate generators of used oil and glycol products on how to dispose and recycle those products.
- Atlantic UOMA serves **BUSINESS GENERATORS** and **CONSUMERS/DIYERS GENERATORS** of used oil and glycol/antifreeze products

Designated Materials



- Used Oil
- Oil Containers (50L or less) including lubricate oil /brake cleaner aerosol containers
- Used Oil Filters
- Used Glycol (Antifreeze)
- Glycol (Antifreeze) Containers (50L or less)

How it Works



- Atlantic UOMA Registered Collectors ***pick up large quantities*** of used oil & glycol materials from over 800+ large generators (garages, other ICI operations etc.) and from waste management authorities and municipalities in the province at no cost
- We support a network of ***139 drop off sites at*** businesses, municipalities, waste management authorities to ensure urban and rural residents of the province have a place to drop off used oil & glycol materials for recycling
- We provide infrastructure, where necessary, to not-for-profit/public facilities to assist with safe storage until collection/removal
- We support Collection Events to serve areas where a permanent drop of site may not be available or viable

Used Oil & Glycol Recycling Benefits



- Ensures compliance with provincial regulations
- Extends the life of the landfill by diverting materials
- Provides safe, regulated site for residents/DIYers to drop off materials banned from landfill
- Having the right infrastructure, in the right place helps curb illegal dumping



- UOMA Zone 5 – takes in Labrador
- 80-90% - of our volumes come from collection /pick up from large generators (garages and industries generating used oil products)
- 10-20% comes from households/DIYers – who have used oil and glycol products to dispose of
- We have a limited number of partners /locations in Labrador to serve the population
- Gap in publicly-operated facilities or Special Collection events in Labrador to serve households /DIY community
