Regional economic development is any activity that increase prosperity in a region however that region defines prosperity.

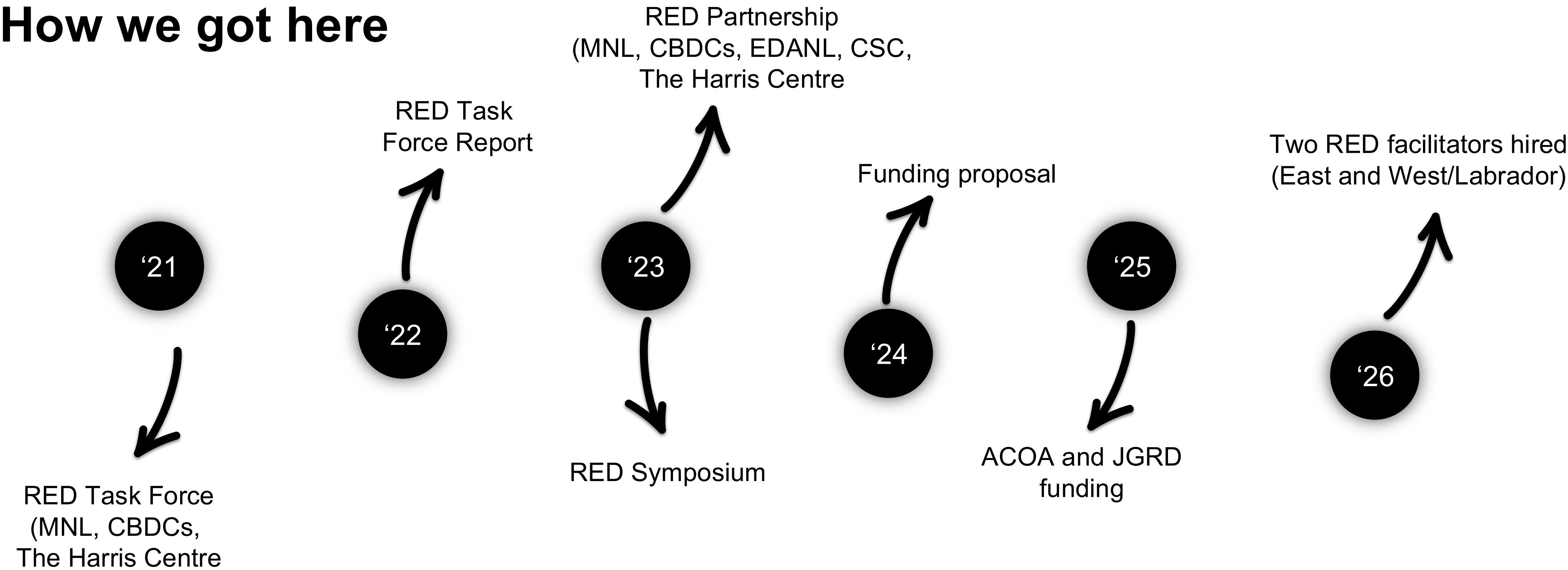

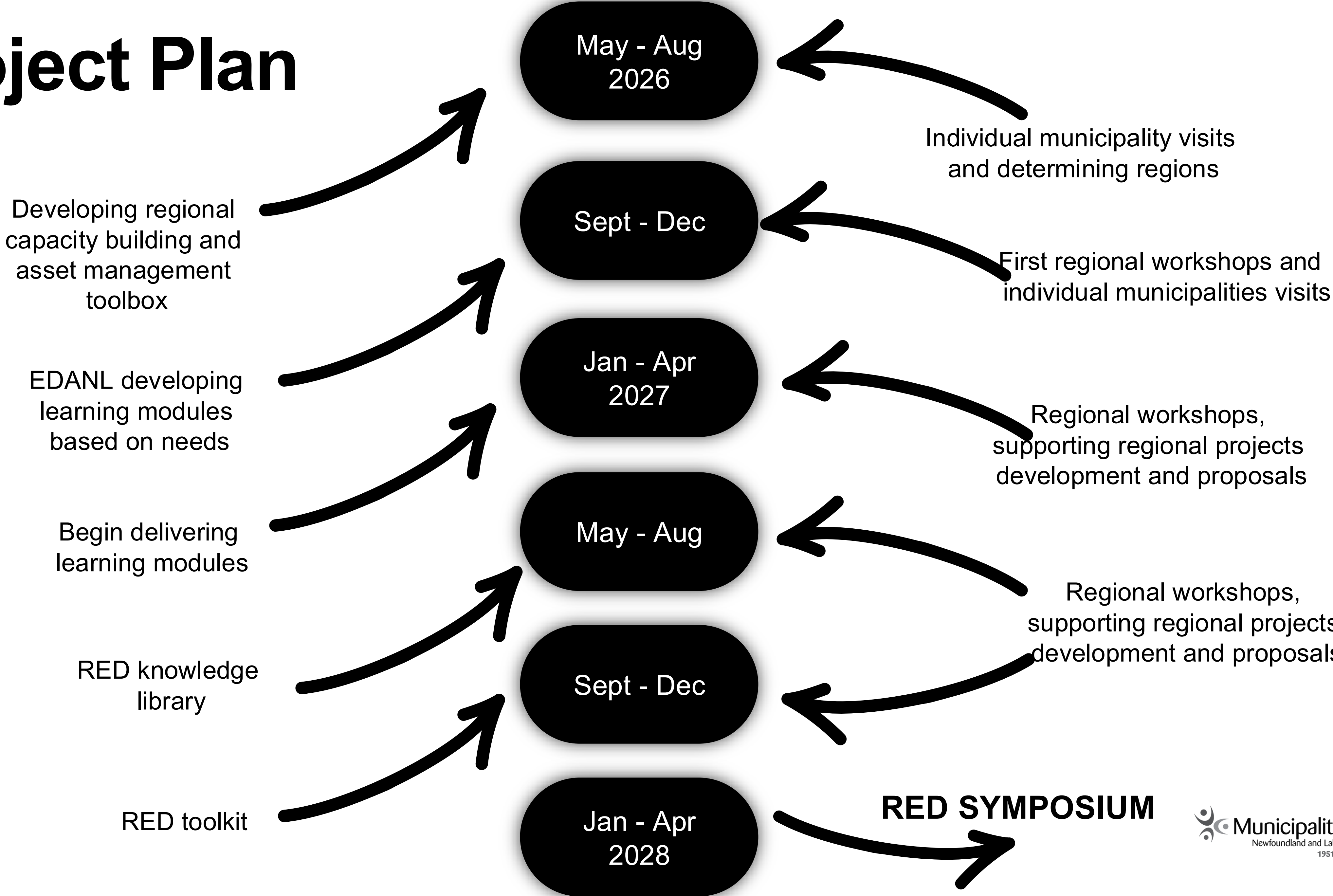

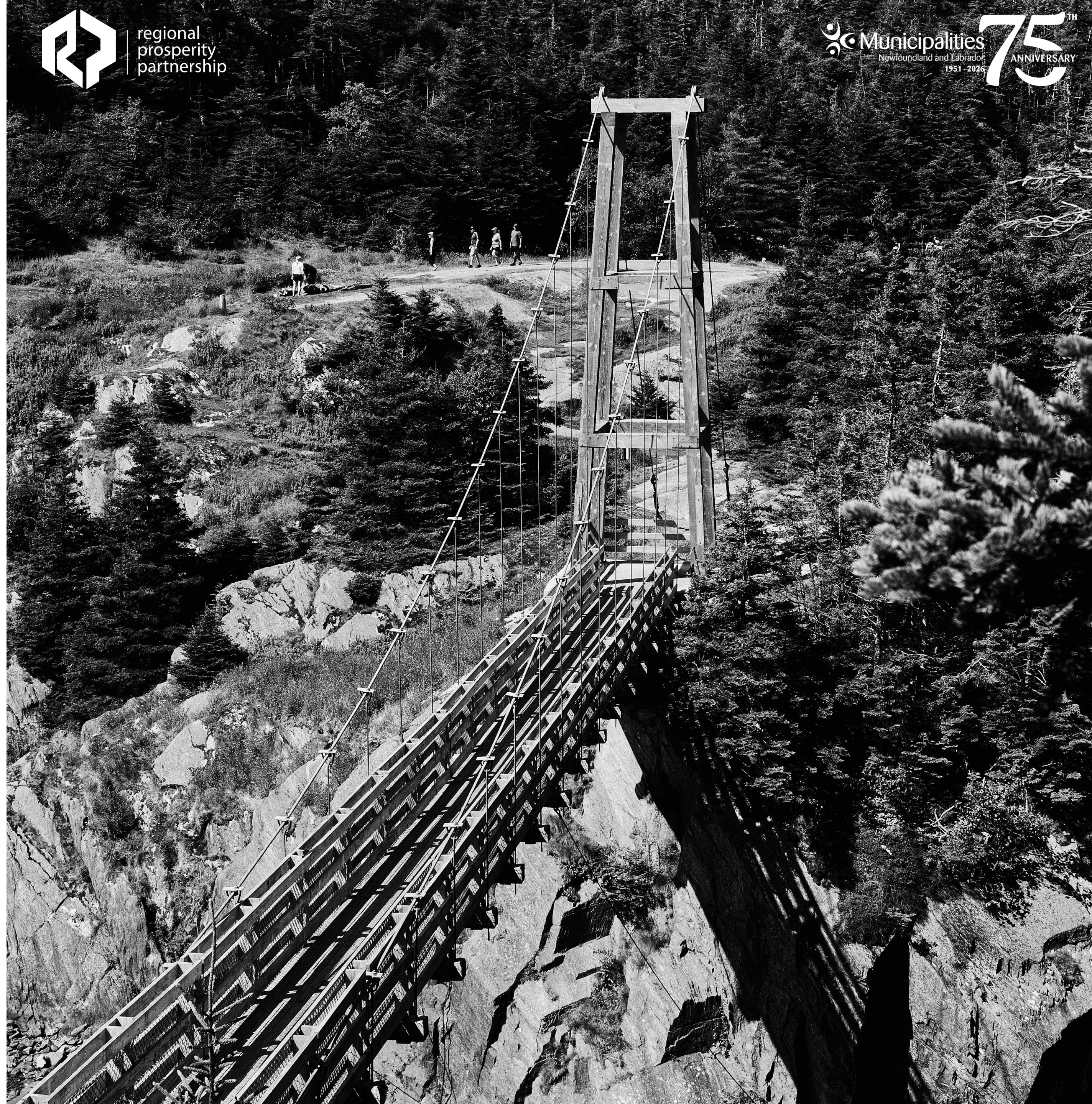
Imagine your region in the next five years, what RED opportunities can your region reasonably pursue?
